Introduction of Rob and Angela from LifeTouch

- Protection on personal information
- Other programs are available (spring, graduation, etc)
- Many options available for choice of picture selection (no packages mandatory, and free to compose package online)
- Several backgrounds available
- 293 coupons awarded to Butler parents, can be used for other programs by LifeTouch (including other schools). Coupons are given for online purchases.
- Cheapest pic is \$10
- Participation rate: around 60%
- Commission: is per package
- Principal scholarship available (typically 10, more available on request)
- Half price if paid on picture day. Write a note: multi child discount and use the flyer. Available for all schools using LifeTouch.

Introduction of Jeff from Eastman Adams

- Emphasis on quality, then price
- They operate photo studios in the past. Many experienced photographers. Local company.
- At least 1 photo per 200 students, to help with organization and student "clean up".
- Less than 1% retakes
- Participation rate: 92% in Canyon View
- Full copyright release for electronic copies
- Packages can be modified online
- Memory book: \$7 (year book type). Kids can be taken out on request from school (no pic, no name, etc)

Jeff's opinion: easy access to Jeff, for school where Jeff has worked with Jeff:  
commission up, participation rate went up. Lifetime does not release full copyright.
